3. The clerk has submitted the paperwork to TSB to update the signatories. Cllrs have been asked to visit the building society and provide the necessary ID.

- 70/18 Tennis courts
Cllr Bywater reported the padlock has been removed from the gate and not returned. Cllr Bywater will reinstate the padlock.
- 71/18 Village shop update
Cllr Wait sent a report to the council prior to the meeting.
The shop committee is looking into a new open/closed sign to be fixed either on a post or fixed to the concrete. Ellie Sainty joined the committee at the last meeting for an update on the pub. She is keen to have a “village” pub and is happy to co-operate with all groups and open to any suggestions as to how the locals would like to see it develop (such as special and charitable events, anybody would like to hold there).
- 72/18 Policing
There has been reports of tyres being slashed at Far Green. Cam and Dursley have also had the same issue.
- 73/18 Speed Survey
Cllr Bywater had nothing further to report regarding the speed calming measures proposed for the village.
- 74/18 Newsletter
The council has received a resignation from Alison Hambling to produce the parish newsletter. Cllrs Burgess and Cook to deliver the final cheque and speak to Alison regarding her decision.

- 76/18 Grant application
The council discussed the application from the village hall cttee requesting financial support to carry out updates to the emergency exit facilities at the hall. The councillors voted to award £2900.00. Clerk to send letter to Mrs B Davis to confirm the amount and conditions.

The clerk has received a response from Nikki Humphries of SDC regarding the council producing a bad weather emergency plan, the council is to contact Nikki if they wish to pursue this.
- 78/18 Defibrillator
Cllr Cook confirmed the village defibrillator is registered with the ambulance service, therefore anyone in need of the defibrillator will not have an issue accessing it.
