117/20	<u>Tennis courts</u> Cllr Cook has read the electricity meter, the clerk will provide this information to Npower and ask for it to be disconnected. Cllr Cook will spray the weeds soon, there is no sign of the Horsetail. Further to the relaxation of the lock down rules the gate is now unlocked, the courts were used almost immediately. 118/20	<u>Village shop</u> Cllr Wait reported the shop is continuing to work well during lockdown with increased sales. The shop now has more than sufficient funds to afford the new building with one or two more donations coming in, they are hopeful the build may be able to start in the next couple of months. The committee have also decided to pay for the collection of waste, this should take some pressure away as this is at present being done by volunteers. Cllr Cook reported the plant swap raised almost £700, half of which will go to the shop.
